Wildlife: 50 cedar waxwings, robins, red-bellied woodpecker, evening grosbeaks, juncos, chickadees, pileated woodpecker, crows, Cooper's hawk, deer, red squirrels, gray squirrel, red fox, turkeys, red tailed hawk, hairy and downy woodpeckers
