

Londonderry Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes
October 12, 2006
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Peskin at 7:12 p.m.

Members Present: Dick Peskin, Bob Trask, Bob Twitchell, Kathie Stone, Aaron Hurst (membership pending) and Marge Malko, Admin. Assistant.

First order of business—

Unfinished Business:

Shamberg Property: The tour of the property will be Oct. 26 at 1 p.m. Aaron Hurst and Sam Schneski have agreed to write the management plan for the Shamberg property. The report will be a fully detailed. Kathie Stone made a motion to accept the offer of the State to do this report with Bob Trask seconding. The motion was passed. The report will be written in the Winter 2007/08. More detail will be determined after the visit on October 26.

Aquifer Study: Grant application for the Windham Foundation for the aquifer study is due November 10. Dick Peskin will be working on this application.

Ancient Roads: A motion was made to recommend to the Select Board that they be concerned about the Ancient Roads and that they consider making a grant application by the Nov. 10 deadline. The motion was made by Kathie Stone and seconded by Bob Twitchell. The motion passed unanimously.

Logging Report: Memorial Park and Sharp Property preliminary work has been done. Logging is planned for the winter.

New Business:

A draft document on Guidelines for the Review and Evaluation of Potential Natural Resources Impacts from Utility-Scale Wind Energy Facilities in Vermont was received. This document will be discussed at the next meeting after all members have a chance to review the information given.

On Nov. 8 7:00-9:30 p.m. at Brattleboro Savings & Loan there will be a meeting on planning for woodland in your estate. The guidelines for the Conservation Fund will be discussed at the next meeting.
