Minutes--October 21, 2010

### **Administrative Matters:**

Treasurer's Report: The Conservation Fund (as of 9/30/10) has a total of \$10,480.66. Conservation Commission: total in both accounts is \$1,971.60

The invasive species article was published in several local publications. Discussion followed on other exotic species spotted on various pieces of land in the area.

ACT 250 Notice: The LCC received an application and hearing notice regarding a development extending the Powder Mill subdivision.
