

**Londonderry Conservation Commission

November 29, 2007**

The meeting was called to order at 7:08 by Dick Peskin, Chairman.

Administrative Matters:

Water testing--tracer methods: Aaron Hurst reported that regarding the elevated e. coli, the Watershed Coordinator, Marie Caduto, is looking into the tracer methods to determine the source of the e. coli. Aaron will be following up on the methodology.

New Business:

AVCC (Assoc. of Vermont Conservation Commissions) Meeting Report--Aaron Hurst reported the topics discussed which included the fish and wildlife assistance on conservation projects, ancient roads and the impact on the local towns and the status of AVCC.

Bob Trask stated that there is a documentary on the West River made by Mr. De Felice in Newfane. Bob will try to reach Mr. DeFelice in order to be able to arrange a viewing of the film.

Bob Twitchell asked Joe Torres about the National Forest Service stewardship projects for the Burnt Meadows sale which is located on Rowley Lane. The town of Londonderry can bid on the project to be involved.

Turkeys, deer, doe and 3 fawns, red-tailed hawk, common red poll, gray squirrels
