

# HAZARDOUS & SPECIAL WASTE

**Please see Transfer Station attendant to find out how to properly dispose of the following FEE ASSOCIATED items:**

SCRAP METAL, TIRES, CLEAN WOOD, APPLIANCES

## **What do I do with latex paint?**

1. TAKE LID OFF
2. FILL CAN WITH KITTY LITTER
3. LEAVE IN SUN TO DRY
4. PLACE THOROUGHLY DRIED PAINT IN COMPACTOR AT TRANSFER STATION

## **What do I do with my batteries and cell phones?**

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES AND CELL PHONES CAN BE RECYCLED AT THE TRANSFER STATION OR LONDONDERRY HARDWARE STORE

Household, alkaline batteries made after 1993 (without mercury) can be put in trash

## **What do I do with my hazardous waste?**

The Londonderry Solid Waste Group consisting of the towns of Landgrove, Londonderry, Peru, Weston and Windham, hosts two Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days per year, one in the spring and one in the fall. Information about dates and times will be available a few weeks in advance. Check with the attendant at the Transfer Station, at the Town Offices and in The Message for the Week. Small businesses that produce less than 220 lbs. of hazardous waste every 3 months but no acutely hazardous waste, may also participate. Registration forms will be mailed before each event.

## **What are Hazardous Wastes that I MUST NOT put in the trash?**

Fluorescent tubes, lamps and the new compact fluorescent bulbs (CFLs), Button cell batteries, waste oil including oil filters, TVs, Computers, Monitors, Rechargeable batteries and cell phones, White goods/ appliances, Tires, oil based paints, varnishes and stains, paint thinner and remover, Nickel Cadmium Batteries, Mercury-Added Products (thermostats, thermometers, manometers, barometers, check product label), Propane Cylinders, Medical Waste, Lead Acid Batteries (Car batteries, etc.)
