TOWN MEETING AND TOWN SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING

The inhabitants of the Town of Londonderry, Vermont, who are legal voters of the Town Meeting and Town School District Meeting, are hereby notified and warned to meet at their Town Hall, Tuesday, March 2nd, A.D. 2010 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. to act on the following Articles, namely:

Article 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at Town meeting and Town School District Meeting.

Article 2: To choose Town Officials required by law to be chosen annually.

Article 3: To elect one (1) Town School Director for a term of three (3) years.

Article 4: To elect (1) Director to serve on the Union District #20 School Board for a term of three (3) years

Article 5: To elect one (1) Trustee to Memorial Park for a term of five (5) years.

Article 6: To see if the Town will vote the sum of \$1,000.00 for the Londonderry Conservation Fund.

Article 7: To see if the Town will vote the sum of \$500.00 for the Memorial Park.

Article 8: To see if the Town will vote a sum not to exceed \$500,000.00, to be paid for over of a period of five years, to build a new Garage at 70 Old School Street to replacing the existing garage.

Article 9: To see if the Town will vote to raise a sum of \$40,000.00 on the Grand List of 2010, this sum of money to be equally divided between Phoenix Fire Company #6, Inc. and Champion Fire Company #5, Inc.

Article 10: To see if the Town will vote to raise a sum of money on the Grand List of 2010 for the Londonderry Volunteer Rescue Squad.

Article 11: To see if the Town will vote to raise a sum of \$17,938.00 for the Mountain Valley Medical Center.

Article 12: To see if the Town will appropriate \$10,000.00 to the South Londonderry Library Association.

Article 13: To see if the Town of Londonderry will raise and appropriate \$1,000.00 to Neighborhood Connections to assist Londonderry in responding to the emergency needs of the community and providing all available and applicable services.

Article 14: To see how much the Town will vote for a General Fund.

Article 15: Shall the voters of the School District approve a total budget in the amount of \$1,926,916.00 which includes the Maximum Inflation Amount of education spending?

Article 16: To see if the voters will increase the exemption from \$10,000.00 to \$40,000.00 of assessed value for all qualified disabled veterans.

Article 17: To see if the Town will pay its taxes to the Town Treasurer as provided by law, due date to be on or before October 1st, 2010?

Article 22: To see if the Town will vote the sum of \$500.00 for the Flood Brook Community Collaborative.


Article 23: To transact any other business that may legally come before the Meeting.






