The Town of Londonderry is seeking bids for construction of driveways to the Salt/Sand Shed on the Prouty Land located at 4215 Rt. 100 in Londonderry.

**Specifications**

The project involves the north and south driveways both of which will be 14 feet in width.

The north driveway will require excavation of surface material, placement of 4 inches of 3 inch minus stone and 4 inches of crushed stone, compacting and finish grading on an identified 100 foot section.

The south driveway will require placement of 6 inches of 3 inch minus stone in an identified areas of 80 feet in length, 4 inches of 3 inch minus in a second identified 80 foot area and a top layer of 2 inch of crushed stone compacted and finish graded on 575 feet of driveway.

Successful bidder will:

- Provide a timeline for work
- Comply with all bid requirements that follow

**Bid Requirements**

Bids should include pricing for all customary tasks required to complete the above listed specifications and a timeline for completion of the project. . Proof of liability insurance, workman's compensation insurance and unemployment insurance must accompany all bids. All state safety standards must be met during construction.

**Bid Submission and Timing**

This notice will appear on the Town's website, [londonderryvt.org](http://londonderryvt.org). Sealed bids should be sent to the Town Office, c/o Londonderry Select Board/Salt Shed Driveway Bid, or may be hand-delivered to the Town Clerk at that address. All bids must be received by noon, November 20, 2017.

Bids will be reviewed and then read aloud at the Select Board meeting to be held at the Town Office on November 20, 2017 at 7:00 PM. The contract will be awarded based on price, qualifications, and the thoroughness of the proposal.

Upon awarding the successful bid, a contract will be agreed upon. The project is extremely time sensitive and must be completed by December 15, 2017.

*The Select Board reserves the right at its sole discretion to reject any and all bids, wholly or in part, to waive any informalities or any irregularities therein, to accept any bid even though it may not be the lowest bid, to call for rebids, to negotiate with any bidder, and to make an award which in its sole and absolute judgment will best serve the Town's interest. The Select Board reserves the right to investigate the financial responsibility of any bidder to determine his or her ability to assure service throughout the term of the contract. The Board also reserves the right to consult with outside sources to determine the ability of a bidder to perform the requirements of the proposal.*
