TOWN OF LONDONDERRY

On Monday, October 16, 2017 the Londonderry Select Board voted to create an ad hoc committee to study the issue of traffic safety and return a recommendation to the Select Board.

The formation of the Traffic Safety Committee is in response to increased complaints to the Select Board regarding traffic safety in general and speed limits in particular. The committee will be tasked with evaluating how the Town of Londonderry should best address these traffic concerns.

The committee will elect a chairperson, hold meetings, and periodically update the Select Board. Meetings of the committee will be subject to Open Meeting laws (warn meetings, post agendas, keep minutes, respect quorum requirements, etc.).

The Select Board will study the committee's recommendation, consider holding public meetings, and determine if a Special Town Meeting is warranted.

This committee will be composed of 5 diverse members of the community who are willing to invest time to represent and serve the community; ideally, there should be representation from our Safety organizations (fire/rescue) and the business community in addition to the community at large. Additionally, a member of the Select Board, George Mora, will serve in an advisory (non-voting) capacity.

Letters of interest from prospective members will be welcomed by the Select Board during the month of November. Emails to townadmin@londonderryvt.org or USPS letters to the Town Office (postmarked by the due date) will be accepted until November 30, 2017. A committee will be appointed at the Select Board meeting on Monday, December 4, 2017.

The committee will submit their recommendation to the Select Board by April 1, 2018.
