Meeting Minutes
September 14, 2017

Present: Committee members Helen Hamman, Barb Wells and Martha Dale.

Meeting minutes: The meeting minutes from the August 3, 2017 meeting were voted as approved.

Treasurer's report: Glebe Mountain Gardens has not yet submitted its invoice for cleanup or the mum plants purchased for the triangle. For next year's budget considerations, the same amount of funds for 2017 will be requested for 2108 - \$3,000. Because the Rotary will be taking over the flag inventory and hanging, and the bridge box expenses will become the responsibility of the Friends of Main Street, which would leave \$1,500 available next year for plantings at the Genser property that is now part of William's park. \$1,500 would be for triangle upkeep and any sign work.

Barrel and bridge box watering: The committee members discussed having a reception for the barrel and bridge box watering volunteers. The date of Tuesday, September 19th was chosen and it will be held at 5:30pm at the Farmers' Market. We especially wanted to thank the teams from Rugg Valley, Glebe Mountain Gardens and Marie and Christopher Porecca.

The committee discussed plantings for next year's barrels and bridge boxes – it was suggested that photos of ideal plant materials be sent to Glebe Mountain for consideration.

Painted wall and Rt. 11: The committee decided that any plantings on the painted wall would be discussed when we are able to meet with VTrans to discuss the status of the wall.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
