Board of Civil Authority Meeting Minutes

The Londonderry Board of Civil Authority met on Thursday November 1st 2018 at 6:30 at the Twitchell Building 100 Old School Street, South Londonderry.

In Attendance: Kelly Pajala, Tina Labeau, Elizabeth Labeau, Bonnie Cobb, Jim Twitchell, Leney Barclay, Margaret Dawedeit, Tom Cavanagh

The Meeting was called to order at 6:30.

The BCA reviewed the list of Voters added to the Checklist as required by Vermont State Statute 17:2144b(d).

There were no requests for at home ballot delivery, so no action was taken to assign pairs of Justices of the Peace to deliver ballots to Voter's homes if needed as required by vss 17:2538(a).

A Handout named Vermont Law on Political Campaigning Outside of Polling Places on Election Day was shared with the BCA. There was discussion about being prepared for protesters and people campaigning outside the building. Leney Barclay made a motion to not allow any political signs to be put in the ground on any Town property and to designate the grassy corner by the end of the walkway as a campaigning area. Tom Cavanagh seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.

Because of being a candidate on the ballot, Kelly Pajala, the Town Clerk asked that the BCA appoint Tina Labeau to be the Presiding Officer at the polls. Tom Cavanagh made a motion as such, Jim Twitchell seconded it. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.

Margaret Dawedeit made a motion to appoint Elizabeth Labeau, Bill Barclay, and Tammy Long as assistant Election Officers as required by vss 17:2452. Bonnie Cobb seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.

Kelly Pajala read off the names and time slot for Elections Officials for November 6th General Election as required by vss 17:2455.

Tom Cavanagh moved that the meeting be adjourned at 6:55. Leney Barclay seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.
