

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR REWRITE OF ZONING BYLAW - 2019**

The Town of Londonderry, Vermont, is seeking a qualified consultant to assist the Town in a comprehensive rewriting of the Town's Zoning Bylaw to

- (1) conform to changes made to the 2017 Londonderry Town Plan,
- (2) update the Bylaw to reflect best practices for municipal zoning in the State of Vermont, and
- (3) reflect the recommendations of the Town's Planning Commission and Selectboard, (collectively, the "Scope of Work").
