

TRANSFER STATION USE POLICY

Town of Londonderry, Vermont

Adopted June 17, 2019

Purpose

The purpose of this Transfer Station Use Policy is to ensure the safety and convenience of all users of the Londonderry Transfer Station.

Property

The Transfer Station, for which this policy is written, is located at 7060 Route 100, parcel #103010.100.

Access

Any property owner or resident, including short- and long-term renters, of a member community of the Londonderry Solid Waste Group (presently Landgrove, Londonderry Peru, Weston and Windham) may have access to the Transfer Station property during regular business hours, provided they have a valid and unexpired access sticker issued by the Londonderry Solid Waste Group either in-hand or affixed to a vehicle.

Parking

Except for Town of Londonderry employees and volunteers, and hired vendors conducting business at the request of the Town, parking throughout the property shall be limited to no more than 15 minutes.

Speed of Travel

Vehicles may travel no faster than 10 miles per hour within the Transfer Station property.

Take-it-or-Leave-it

Regarding the "Take-it-or-Leave-it" shed, the following limitations shall apply:

- Visitors may leave items at any time during normal business hours provided items left are not considered to be of no value to Transfer Station employees or volunteers.
- Visitors may only take items from the facility free of charge one time per day during regular business hours, though there are no limitations on the number of items a visitor may take at that time.
- Before any subsequent visit to take items in any given day, visitors must first have their Transfer Station punch card marked/punched two times for each visit.

Duration of Facility Use/Loitering

Visitors may not remain at the Transfer Station more than 15 minutes unless specifically invited to do so by Transfer Station staff.


Penalties


Anyone violating any of the above policies shall be given a verbal warning by Transfer Station staff, who shall document such verbal warning. If within a three (3) month period from the verbal warning the same individual violates any of the above policies, such individual shall receive a written warning by Transfer Station staff. If within a three (3) month period from the written warning the same individual violates any of the above policies, such individual shall receive from the Town a notice against trespass, which shall deny the individual entry to the Transfer Station property for up to one (1) year. Anyone


violating the terms of a notice against trespass shall be subject to arrest, fines and prosecution as provided for under 13 V.S.A. 3705(a).

The foregoing Policy is hereby adopted by the Selectboard of the Town of Londonderry, Vermont, this 17th day of JUNE and is effective as of this date until amended or repealed.


