## Board of Civil Authority Minutes

The Londonderry Board of Civil Authority met on Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 5:00 at the Twitchell Building 100 Old School Street, South Londonderry Vermont.

In attendance: Maureen Cronin, Debbie O’Leary, Julie Charlton, Kelly Pajala, Tina Labeau, Bonnie Cobb, Darcy Duval, Helena Wu

The meeting was called to order at 5:02.

Kelly Pajala shared a brief description of the polling place policies that have been set in the past. Maureen Cronin made a motion to hang up “silence your cell phone signs” in the polling place, set the grassy corner at the start of the front walkway as the area for people to stand to hold signs, and to not allow any political signs to be placed on any Town owned property for the remainder of the 2022 election cycle. Julie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

The Board reviewed the list of voters added to the Checklist as required by Vermont State Statute 17:2144b(d). The last election was Town Meeting held on April 30, 2022. There was a question about one voter having a N18 designation. Kelly explained that voters who will turn 18 by the general election can register and vote in the Primary.

There were no requests for pairs of Justices of the Peace to deliver ballots to Voter’s homes.

Darcy Duval made a motion to appoint Elizabeth Labeau to be an assistant Election Officers for the remainder of the 2022 election year as required by vss 17:2452. Julie Charlton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

There was a brief discussion about who was helping at the polls and when. There was a discussion about the lay out of the polling place and where the check-in table, ballot box, polls watchers’ location and exit would be. There was mention of attempting to get an air conditioner in the polling place. There was some discussion about the new vote tabulator and ballot box that was provided by the State of Vermont. The Board discussed strategies for making people feel comfortable with the new equipment in this first user experience.

Kelly Pajala made a motion to adjourn at 5:30. Tina seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with a voice vote.
