Sale of cemetery plots – Maureen reports that she has been very busy selling lots. There are only 5 lots left in Collins. When Collins is full the only burial lots available will be in Glebe View and River Side.

Old business – Question was raised about whether or not Melvin had ordered a new headstone for River Side?

New business – Cemeteries will close on 11/1 and people will be asked to remove everything by 11/11. Laurie will publicize in the necessary places.
