Meeting Minutes June 12, 2023**

Meeting Minutes: The meeting minutes from the May 9, 2023 meeting were approved by consensus without changes.

Treasurer's report: There was a balance of \$1845 after the May meeting. Glebe's bill was \$1496. Additional expenses mulch \$30, plants for the Mobil barrel \$89, leaving a small balance of which will be spent on additional mulch and plants for the town garden.

Selectboard approved member terms: All members have been approved for 1, 2 or 3 year terms by the Selectboard.

Town gardens, bridge boxes, barrels and watering schedule updates:

Barrels have been planted. Barb planted and mulched the Mobil barrel. Town office needs mulch and some color in front of the Memorial.

Gale and Barb will attend to the Brown garden next week and Gale will be working on the triangle with Helen's help. All members have been asked to send a note out when they'll be working for additional help from any of us who can be available on short notice.

Martha mentioned wire baskets with coir and plants under the welcome signs might be a nice addition to include in the next year's budget. Martha has seen it in other towns and it looks good.

Watering: Sign-ups are coming along with most commitments up to about a month out. 49/160 spots have been signed up. We are continuing to publicize the need and will have the signup sign at the farmer's market guest table.

Property at NE Corner of Routes 100 and 11 update: Marlene provided an update on the project along with feedback received from town stakeholders. The project continues to move forward. A mockup of plantings is up for the next 2 weeks to assess sight lines for traffic.

Banners: Barb and Bonny provided an update on banners which is in early design phase.

No new business.
